A practical CPDL workshop focusing on how music can help children in EYFS with their speech, language and communication development

Songs and rhymes are the first stories shared with us from birth, and their use in education has long been linked to helping children with their speech, language, and communication development.

Singing songs, chanting rhymes and sharing stories creates opportunities to learn at a fundamental and deep level - and is joyous! It is accessible to everyone, and you can make use of the resources you already have available to you.

A Songs, Rhymes and StoryTimes workshop is ideally suited to a twilight CPDL session, or as part of a longer training day. It lasts for an hour and a half (this can be extended if needed) and will equip you with songs, rhymes, games and recommended stories that can be put into action straight away. It will allow you to develop your confidence with embedding musical skills into your EYFS curriculum.

In the workshop we will explore:

- A repertoire of age-appropriate songs, rhymes and stories
- Strategies for sharing stories in different ways
- How using pictures books can help embed music learning within early years provision
- Making the most of your materials and resources
