- 2 GCSEs at grade 5
- 3 GCSEs at grade 4 or higher including Maths and English Language

This Pathway is **Applied subjects**

Entry Requirements:

- 4 GCSEs at grade 4 or higher including English Language or Maths
- GCSE Maths and English Language can be no lower than a 3

As well as meeting our entry criteria for our Pathways, you'll also need to meet our other expectations:

95%+ attendance
 A good school report
 Plus any subject specific entry criteria
