

WHY STUDY MUSIC TECHNOLOGY?

Music is used as a powerful tool to get social, political and entertainment agendas across in society and you can play your part in its continual development.

This programme is designed to give you a solid base for work in the dynamic music industry as a creative music technician or allow progression to a higher level course.

The course focuses on technology as a tool for the creative musician. Much of the work involves original composition and production. Each project you complete is designed to be realistic to what you would expect in industry.

With an industry standard recording studio and state of the art mixing desk, students can combine compositions created, using many of our on-hand instruments and midi controllers.

This course is designed to support progression to apprenticeship or employment when taken as part of a programme of study that includes other appropriate BTEC Nationals or A Levels.

Ultimately this course is the basis of study for the sound engineering sector with a focus on studio recording techniques and DAW production.
